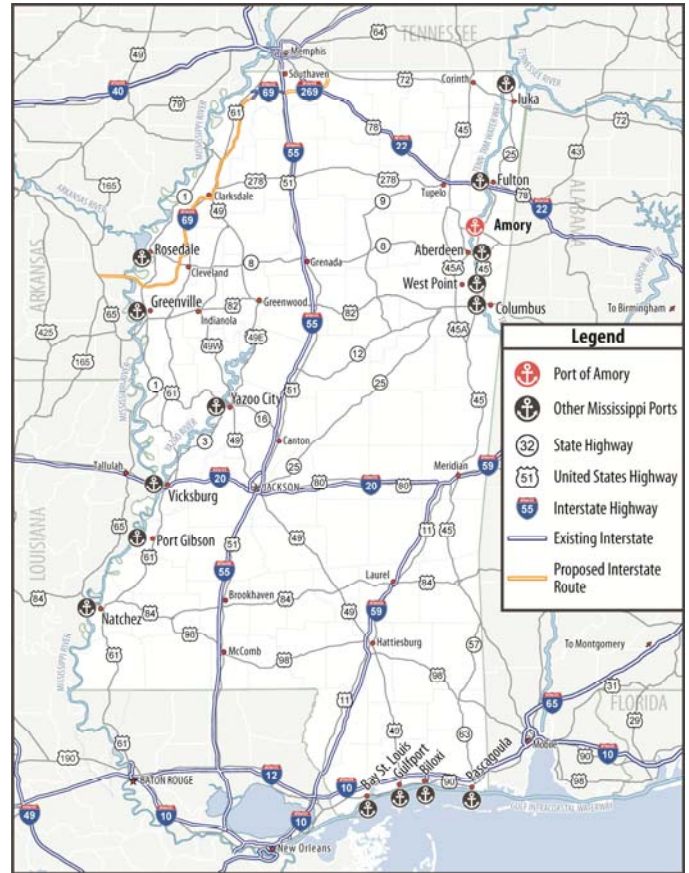


Port of Amory

Rail Direct access to Class 1 BN via port rail spur

Facilities

Public terminal with 800 feet of notched, bulkhead barge berthing area, 7 domes of storage, unpaved open storage, bridge crane

Typical Cargoes

Wood chips, wood pellets, rock salt, soybeans, ore, pet coke, calcined sand, steel, gravel, and raw materials for chemical industry

Services

Barge loading/unloading, general freight transfer including grain and lumber, barge fleetling, storage, mooring assistance
