

ORDINANCE NO. 1435

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF AMORY, MISSISSIPPI, PROHIBITING THE SHOOTING OF AIR RIFLES, PELLET GUNS, SLING SHOTS, FIREARMS, AND PRIMITIVE WEAPONS IN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF AMORY, MISSISSIPPI, REPEALING PREVIOUS ORDINANCE NO. 1234, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Amory, Monroe County, Mississippi duly assembled in a regular meeting at its regular meeting place in the City Hall of said City at 7:00 o'clock P. M. on the 3rd day of March, 1981, a quorum being present, as follows:

SECTION 1. That from and after the effective date of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to shoot, fire or discharge any air rifle, pellet gun, sling shot, or any type firearm, or any primitive weapon, such as a cross bow, compound bow, or recurved bow, within the corporate limits of the City of Amory.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to any program of instruction conducted by the Amory Municipal Separate School District on public school property.

SECTION 3. That any person violating any provision of this ordinance may be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00.

SECTION 4. That previous Ordinance No. 1234 of the City of Amory, Mississippi, and all other ordinances in conflict herewith be and are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force as provided by law.

This ordinance having been first reduced to writing was read, considered, voted upon, adopted and passed, first section by section, and then as a whole, on a "Yea" and "Nay" vote.
