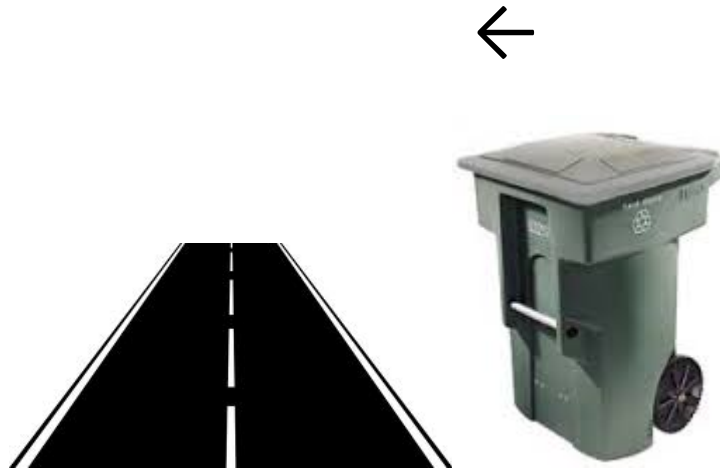


NOTICE FROM CITY OF AMORY
MONROE COUNTY
GARBAGE CART COLLECTION
SCHEDULED TO START APRIL 2016

UPON DELIVERY AND ON YOUR REGULAR COLLECTION DAY:



Please place your garbage cart where it faces the street.

- ***The cart will be delivered and placed where we would like for you to position it on collection day.***
- ***The goal is to place the cart approximately five (5) feet from the nearest road without blocking the mail box. We understand that this will not be possible in some circumstances.***
- ***Within 30 days after receiving the Cart all roadside bins, barrels, or other garbage storage structure must be cleaned and removed. If you need assistance in removing your storage structure (after your cart is delivered) call 256-5635***
- ***Please remove the cart from collection area as soon as possible after garbage is collected.***

Collection Rules:

Garbage shall be bagged before being placed in the cart and the accumulated weight of all materials in the cart shall not exceed 200 pounds.

Loose garbage will not be picked up. Loose garbage is a disease and injury risk to our collection personnel, impedes productivity and creates litter that can easily become airborne during the loading process.

Overflow bags or boxes that will not go into the container will be picked up. Bags may be placed in other plastic containers to protect the garbage from animals.

An additional cart may be provided for an additional charge per month. Call the number at the bottom of this notice for further information.

Monroe County will dump other roll out commercial carts provided by the resident but; under no circumstances shall Monroe County be responsible for damage caused by mechanically dumping these containers.

Waste such as sofas, mattresses, recliners, appliances, vegetation and other bulky waste shall be collected by the city on the regular garbage collection day by a separate unit.

Materials that should not be placed in the Cart are as follows:

- **Bricks, asphalt, concrete**
- **Boards over two (2) feet in length**
- **Heavy metal objects**
- **House hazardous waste including but not limited to paints, paint thinner, household chemicals, pesticides, herbicides, etc. (Empty containers that contained these materials are acceptable)**

- **Liquid Waste (cooking oil, etc.)**
- **Large Batteries (automobile, tractor, lawnmower, etc.)**
- **Shingles, sheet rock, toilets, sinks, rugs, carpets, or other bulky waste or rubbish that may cause damage/harm to cart or collection personnel by either excessive weight or sharp extrusion**
- **Stable matter, dead animal, or human excrements, needles, body fluids or any other material that may harbor infectious diseases.**
- **Limbs, leaves or yard waste.**
