

OverDrive Instructions

What type of device are you using?

- I. Kindle, Kindle Fire, Kindle Fire HD
- II. Android or iOS Smartphone/Tablets (including Sony Reader wifi, Nook HD, Google Nexus, iPad, iPhone, etc.)
- III. e-ink eReaders and Nook Color (Kobo, Sony Reader etc.)

I. Kindle or Kindle Fire

Step 1: What you'll Need

1. Email Account
2. Amazon Account
3. Your Kindle Device (must be registered with your email account)
4. Library Card Number and Pin
5. Web Browser on a Computer (for Kindle) or on your Kindle Fire's Web Browser

Step 2: Download eBooks from Overdrive and Amazon

1. Go to <http://www.tombigbee.lib.ms.us/>
2. Click on the Overdrive icon link to access the catalog.
3. Browse by category or do an Advanced Search. You can search by title, author, date added to site, subject, format, or availability.
4. Choose your eBook.
 - a. Click on the picture of the book you want.
 - b. Check the available formats and make sure "Kindle book" is listed.
 - c. Click "borrow".
5. Sign-In
 - a. From the dropdown box select "Tombigbee Regional Library".
 - b. Input "library card number and PIN".
 - c. This signs you into your bookshelf.
 - d. A picture of your book shows up. On the right hand side of the book are two boxes. One says "download (select one format)", the other says "read (in your browser)".
 - e. Click on the down arrow in "download" box.
 - f. Click on box next to "Kindle book."
 - g. Click on "confirm and download."
 - h. This opens a new internet window to Amazon.
6. You are now at Amazon.com
 - a. Click "get library book."
 - b. Sign in to your Amazon account
 - i. Email address and password.
 - c. Choose which Kindle device you want to read your book on.
 - i. Click "continue"

- ii. The eBook should now be downloaded to your Kindle if you have a WiFi connection. If your eBook is not on your Kindle sync your Kindle.
 1. If that doesn't work. Click on "your account."
 2. Click on "manage your Kindle" under digital content.

This brings up your Kindle library. Your eBook should be listed under title and "borrowed" will be written in red next to the title.
 3. Click on "actions"
 - a. Click on "deliver to my" and choose your device.
 - b. Click "deliver" and sync your Kindle, which will download your content to your device.

Step 3: Returning Your eBook in Early

1. You may end your library loan early by visiting "manage your Kindle," in you Amazon account.
2. Click on "actions" across from the title and choose "return this book".
3. You will receive an email confirmation.

II. Smartphone or Tablet

Step 1: What you'll Need

1. Email Account
2. Adobe ID Account
 - a. Go to the website, www.adobe.com, to sign up for a free account
 - b. Click the "Sign In" link at the top right hand corner.
 - c. Click "Don't have an Adobe ID?"
3. Library Card Number and Pin
4. Apple ID password or Google Play password to download app
5. Overdrive Console Media App

Step 2: Install App onto your tablet/smartphone

1. Go to your app store ("App Store" for Apple devices or "Google Play Store" for Android devices).
2. Search for Overdrive Console Media
3. Install the app.

Step 3: Downloading an eBook

1. Click "Add a library"
2. Find and select your library "Tombigbee Regional Library"
3. Select "Mississippi eBook Library Partnership"
4. Browse by category or do an Advanced Search. You can search by title, author, date added to site, subject, format, or availability.
5. Choose your eBook.
 - a. Click on the picture of the book you want.
 - b. Check the available formats and make sure "Adobe ePUB eBook" is listed.
 - c. Click "borrow".
6. Sign-In
 - a. From the dropdown box select "Tombigbee Regional Library".
 - b. Input "library card number and PIN".
 - c. This signs you into your bookshelf.
 - d. A picture of your book shows up. On the right hand side of the book are two boxes. One says "download (select one format)", the other says "read (in your browser)"
 - e. Click on the down arrow in "download" box.
 - f. Click on the Box "Download ePUB ebook".

g. Click on Confirm & Download.

7. Go to your Bookshelf

8. Click on the eBook to read.

Step 4: Returning Your eBook in Early

1. Click and hold the book jacket of the book until a menu pops up.

2. Select "Return".

3. Confirm "Return".

III. e-ink eReaders and Nooks (Kobo, Sony Reader etc.)

Step 1: What you'll Need

1. Email Account
2. Adobe ID Account
 - a. Go to the website, www.adobe.com, to sign up for a free account
 - b. Click the "Sign In" link at the top right hand corner.
 - c. Click "Don't have an Adobe ID?"
 - d. Enter your information and confirm your account through your email.
3. Library Card Number and Pin
4. Web Browser on a Computer (for Kindle) or on your Kindle Fire's Web Browser

Step 2: Install Adobe Digital Editions (ADE) to a computer or laptop

4. Go to <http://www.adobe.com/products/digital-editions.html>
5. Click on "Download now" link in the box to the right.
6. Click on "Windows" or "Macintosh" depending on your computer.
7. Follow the instructions to install ADE on your computer.

Step 3: Authorize your computer with ADE.

1. Open Adobe Digital Editions.
2. Authorize your computer when asked. If it does not ask you, from the "Help" menu, select "Authorize Computer"
3. Input your Adobe ID to sign in and authorize your computer

Step 4: Download eBooks from Overdrive

1. Go to <http://www.tombigbee.lib.ms.us/>
2. Click on the Overdrive icon link to access the catalog.
3. Browse by category or do an Advanced Search. You can search by title, author, date added to site, subject, format, or availability.
4. Choose your eBook.
 - a. Click on the picture of the book you want.
 - b. Check the available formats and make sure "ePUB ebook" is listed.
 - c. Click "borrow".
5. Sign-In to Overdrive
 - a. From the dropdown box select "Tombigbee Regional Library".
 - b. Input "library card number and PIN". This signs you into your bookshelf.

- c. A picture of your book shows up. On the right hand side of the book are two boxes. One says "download (select one format)", the other says "read (in your browser)"
- d. Click on the down arrow in "download" box.
- e. Click on the Box "Download ePUB ebook".
- f. Confirm download.

Step 5: Transfer the eBook to your Device from ADE

1. Click "Open" to open the eBook into ADE. It may take a moment to download.
2. Click on the "Library" button to return to the ADE Library.



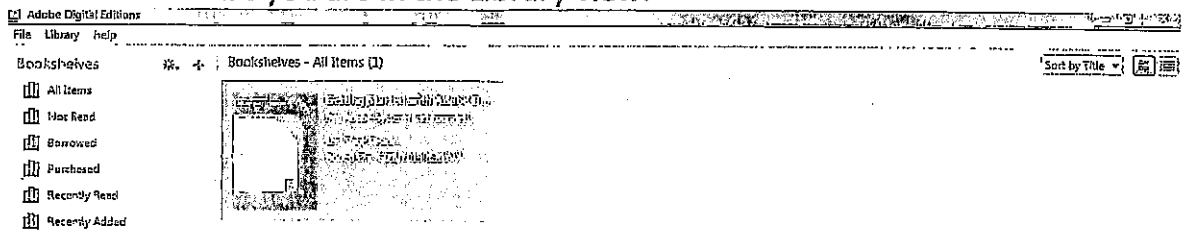

3. Plug your device using its USB cable into the computer.
4. Your device will show up on the left hand side of the ADE window.
5. Click and drag your book onto the device.
6. Properly eject the eBook from your device.

Step 6: Returning the eBook in Early

1. In ADE make sure you are in the Library view.



2. Select the book by left clicking once.
3. Right click the book and select "Return Borrowed Item"
